The International Professional Certification Programme

The **International Certificate in Supply Chain Management**, awarded after successful completion of the exams for individual Modules 1-6 or 3 in 1 (modules 1-3 and modules 4-6)

 \Box The Advanced International Certificate in Supply Chain Management, awarded after successful completion of the exams for the above Modules plus individual Modules 7-12. or 3 in 1 (modules 7-9 and modules 10-12)

 \Box The International Diploma in Supply Chain Management, awarded upon successful completion of all the 12 Modules plus individual Modules 13-18 or 3 in 1 (modules 13-15 and 16-18)

Through a reciprocity agreement with the Institute for Supply Management (ISM) in the US, holders of ITC's MLS-SCM diploma can also apply to ISM to obtain the Certified Professional in Supply Management® (CPSM®) credential.

In Nepal, IEDI is one and only Authorised Examination Body (AEB) of the Geneva-based International Trade Centre (ITC)-UN/WTO. The exams themselves are developed and marked by an international panel of experts consisting of high-level specialists from all continents.
